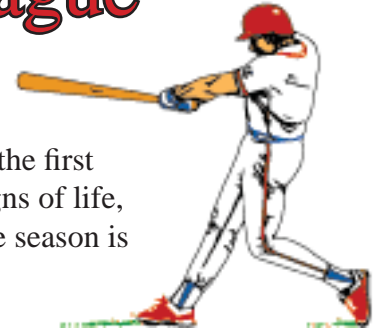


Exeter-West Greenwich Little League
